TRAVEL DATES

TRAVEL FROM POINT OF ORIGIN MUST COMMENCE NO EARLIER THAN 01MARXX.

ADVANCE RESERVATIONS/TICKETING

RESERVATIONS MUST BE CONFIRMED FOR ALL PORTIONS OF THE ITINERARY NO LATER THAN 3 DAYS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE FROM ORIGIN. TICKETS MAY NOT BE ISSUED EARLIER THAN 17FEBXX. TRAVEL FROM LAST POINT OF STOPOVER MUST COMMENCE NO LATER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER DEPARTURE FROM ORIGIN.

DAY/TIME APPLICATION

FARES APPLY FOR TRAVEL ON FLIGHTS SCHEDULED TO DEPART DAILY FROM 600 PM THRU MIDNIGHT.

- OR -

FARES APPLY FOR TRAVEL ON FLIGHTS SCHEDULED TO DEPART DAILY FROM 1201 AM THRU 630 AM.

LEARNING ADVICE

See the following page for explanations for the components of this rule display. Each CRS will write the rule display differently, using different headings for the subjects or categories.

REMINDER: Fares, taxes, fees, commissions, and commission caps change periodically. Amounts and percentages used in the text are for training purposes only. You must learn the principles and the processes.

SEASONAL APPLICATION

FARES APPLY FOR TRAVEL DURING THE PERIOD 13 JAN THRU 22 JUN.

- OR -

FARES APPLY FOR TRAVEL DURING THE PERIOD 24 SEP THRU 13 DEC.

FARES APPLY FOR TRAVEL DURING THE PERIOD 25 DEC THRU 26 DEC.

PERMITTED COMBINATIONS

FARES MAY BE COMBINED WITH AC FARES BETWEEN THE 50 U.S. STATES AND CANADA OR WITH FARES WITHIN CANADA.

A CIRCLE TRIP ITINERARY IS PERMITTED.

NO MORE THAN 2 STOPOVERS ARE PERMITTED ON A CIRCLE TRIP ITINERARY.

THE OUTWARD DESTINATION IS CONSIDERED A STOPOVER POINT ON A CIRCLE TRIP ITINERARY.

AN OPEN JAW ITINERARY IS PERMITTED BETWEEN OUTWARD DESTINATION AND RETURN POINT OF DEPARTURE.

AN OPEN JAW ITINERARY IS PERMITTED BETWEEN POINT OF ORIGIN AND FINAL DESTINATION.

NO ADDITIONAL STOPOVERS ARE PERMITTED ON AN OPEN JAW ITINERARY.

THE OPEN JAW CITIES ARE NOT CONSIDERED STOPOVER POINTS ON AN OPEN JAW ITINERARY.

DEPOSITS/SERVICE CHARGES

TICKETS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

- OR -

A SERVICE CHARGE OF 100.00 CAD WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ITINERARY CHANGES WITH OR WITHOUT TICKET REISSUE.

- (1) Entry to retrieve ALL rule subjects for this fare from a rules menu.
- (2) General Information includes: carrier code (Air Canada), tariff book containing rule, booking code, rule number in ATPCO Tariff, fare type—excursion round-trip. Therefore, a fare governed by this rule cannot be cut in half for a one-way trip.
- (3) The normal fare construction rule does not apply because the specific rules of this fare govern not only the fare application, but the fare construction.

TRAVEL DATES This fare is not valid for travel until March 1.

ADVANCE RESERVATIONS/TICKETING To qualify for this fare the reservation must be made no later than 3 days prior to departure. After the reservation has been made, the ticket must be purchased and issued no later than 7 days after the reservation is confirmed and at least 3 days before departure. The ticket cannot be issued before February 17.

MINIMUM STAY The earliest possible date of return is the first Sunday after the date of departure.

MAXIMUM STAY A 90-day stay is the maximum allowed with this fare.

DAY/TIME APPLICATION Flights scheduled to depart from 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. must be booked for this fare.

SEASONAL APPLICATION Look closely at this one. Travel is only allowed January 13 through June 22, September 24 through December 13, and December 25 and December 26.

PERMITTED COMBINATIONS You can combine this fare only with other Air Canada fares. Circle-trips are permitted. This rule allows a circle-trip or open-jaw trip, but only 2 stopovers are permitted. In this rule the open-jaw cities are not considered stopover points.

DEPOSITS/SERVICE CHARGES No refunds. A service charge of \$100.00 in Canadian dollars is assessed for itinerary changes.

Summary

Every normal, discounted, and excursion fare has a fare rule. The fare rule contains all of the travel conditions and restrictions for a particular fare as identified by the fare basis code. Some fares have more restrictions than others and therefore those rules will be longer. Each fare rule is divided into informational categories or subjects. Each category describes a particular type of restriction or condition of travel including:

- ✘ **Booking Code**
- ✘ **Reservations and Ticketing**
- ✘ **Day/Time Application**
- ✘ **Blackouts**
- ✘ **Flight Application**
- ✘ **Open Return**
- ✘ **Co-Terminals**
- ✘ **Reroute**
- ✘ **Penalties/Changes**
- ✘ **Minimum and Maximum Stay**
- ✘ **Seasonal Application**
- ✘ **Effective/Expiration Dates**
- ✘ **Stopovers/Open-Jaw**
- ✘ **Combinability**
- ✘ **Surcharges and Fees**
